



Masquerade Dress Code & Guidelines

To help create a fun, elegant, and respectful environment for all students, we ask that attendees follow the dress code below.

Our goal is for everyone to feel confident, comfortable, and appropriately dressed for a Christ centered academy- sponsored event.

Attire Expectations -

Spring Fling is a semi-formal masquerade dance.

Appropriate attire includes:

- Dresses, skirts, dressy tops, or modest jumpsuits
- Dress pants, button-down shirts, polos, blazers, or suits
- Dress shoes or clean sneakers appropriate for semi-formal wear

To ensure modesty and comfort while dancing:

- Dresses and skirts should be an appropriate length (recommended: fingertip length or longer)
- Necklines and backs should provide adequate coverage
- Midriffs should remain covered at all times
- Clothing should not be excessively tight, sheer, or revealing
- Undergarments should not be visible
- No clothing with inappropriate graphics, language, or imagery

Students may be asked to adjust attire or contact parents if clothing does not meet event expectations.

Masquerade Mask Guidelines

Masks are welcome and encouraged to match the masquerade theme!

To keep the atmosphere fun and appropriate:

Allowed:

- Decorative masquerade masks
- Elegant or festive masks that coordinate with formal attire
- Masks that allow clear visibility and easy identification

Not Allowed:

- Horror or frightening masks (ex: scream-style, horror characters, or scary costumes)
- Full-face costume masks
- Masks that fully conceal identity
- Masks with weapons, gore, or inappropriate themes

Chaperones may ask students to remove masks at check-in or at any time during the dance for identification or safety purposes.
